MGM Resorts International Sponsors the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Annual Parade in Downtown Las Vegas

Las Vegas, January 19, 2019 – On Monday, Jan. 21, the Las Vegas community will come together to participate in the 37th annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade. MGM Resorts International (NYSE: MGM) will be the presenting sponsor of the parade for the ninth consecutive year.

Hailed as one of the nation's largest parades west of the Mississippi River celebrating the ideals and life of Dr. King, this year's parade theme is "One People, One Nation, One Dream." The parade will kick off at 10 a.m. with the route starting at Fourth Street and Cass Avenue. It will continue north on Fourth to Ogden Avenue, where it will conclude.

As always the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Committee, the nonprofit organization that plans and hosts the parade, promises this year's parade to provide a variety of entertainment, including floats, exotic vehicles, marching bands and dancers. Public officials and representatives of area nonprofit organizations are also expected to participate in the event.

The physical and spiritual atrocities that continue to happen daily across our nation and the world are blunt reminders that Dr. King's quest for universal respect for all humanity is unfinished. We should all embrace his dream, and his teachings should mobilize all of us – regardless of who or where we are – to champion every day the equal rights of every human being to life, dignity, liberty and the pursuit of happiness," said Phyllis A. James, Chief Diversity and Corporate Responsibility Officer for MGM Resorts International.

In March of 2018, MGM Resorts International donated \$150,000 to the National Civil Rights Museum in Memphis. The funds will support the Museum's programming surrounding the 50th anniversary of the assassination of Dr. King, which took place at the Lorraine Motel, now the location of the National Civil Rights Museum. This year employees from MGM Resorts' Gold Strike Casino Resort, just 45 minutes away from the Museum, will continue what has become an annual tradition, and will once again serve as volunteers giving brief history of various exhibits, helping with general questions and giving directions to visitors during the year's Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
